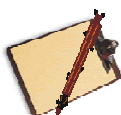


We will end 2009 by donating funds raised from our block of the month (BOM) to St.

Civil War Block of Month



Beginning early 2010, we are excited to offer a Block of the Month inspired by the "Civil War Tribute" collection by Judie

Rothermel for Marcus Brothers Fabrics to honor the 150 year Anniversary of the Civil War. The finished size will be 100" x 112". This quilt highlights a variety of sawtooth and star blocks. Each of the quilt blocks represents a major battle fought during the Civil War and patterns include historical references about the corresponding battles from both the South and North perspectives. Cost will be \$25 per month and will include assembly instructions by a PMQS staff member on the 2nd Wednesday and Saturday of each month. Hurry, space is limited as many quilters have already signed up.

*Discounts do not include Blocks of the Month.

Madeira Nightgown Class will be offered in December. Evening classes will be in 2 parts (embroidery & construction) and includes pattern. Learn how to make a fine gown using Martha Pullen cotton and embroidery. If you do not have an embroidery machine, it can be done at the shop for an additional fee. Class is \$40 and you must sign up by 12/10.
